The Industrial Millwright Pre-Apprenticeship program is a **free** skills-based program that enables students to explore and develop skills related to the Industrial Mechanic Millwright (433A) trade.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- Students will learn:
 - Industry techniques in maintaining and repairing factory equipment and automated systems
 - Theory and practice of machine fabrication and repair
 - Maintenance needs of manufacturing and production industry
 - Measurements, mathematics, blueprint interpretation
- Program content based on input from industry and George Brown College's Centre for Construction & Engineering Technologies
- Most courses provide graduates with Ontario Public College credits which may be applied towards an apprenticeship program
- First aid and safety certification included
- Program includes a supported industry work placement
- Starting pay range for this industry is \$16.00-\$25.00 per hour

THIS PROGRAM WILL PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH

- Ontario post-secondary credits
- Level 1-equivalent training
- Exposure to entry level employment
- Information on apprenticeships

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Interested applicants will be assessed for English and Math skills (Ontario Grade 12 or equivalent)
- Applicants must have a current resume and be able to demonstrate interest and suitability to both training and employment in millwright
- Must be able to work in Ontario
- Permanent resident or Canadian citizen
- Must be able to commit to 32 weeks of training
