Neighbourhood Assistance & Support Guide

Communities are made better by neighbours who take care of each other. This decision tree will help you to determine the best person to contact if you want to help someone in need or report an issue in the neighbourhood.

REMEMBER: In an emergency situation that requires immediate assistance from the police, fire department or ambulance, call 911 immediately.

Who should I call?

Is there an immediate risk to someone's property, health, or well-being?



- Call 9-1-1 in an emergency
- To report crimes anonymously, call Crime Stoppers at: 416-222-TIPS (8477)
- Toronto Police Service Non-Emergency line: 416-808-2222
